# **COMMUNITY COLLABORATION FOR CHILDREN (CCC)**

In-home based services that educate, strengthen and support families to prevent child abuse and neglect. CCC empowers the family unit by promoting the safety, well-being, strength, and stability of children and families by teaching problem-solving skills, appropriate discipline techniques, self- sufficiency, and by coordinating community resources. Services address children's physical, mental, emotional, and educational needs while strengthening and supporting families. ## FAMILY RESOURCE AND YOUTH SERVICES CENTERS (FRYSC)

These centers help connect students and their families to needed services as a way to remove nonacademic barriers to learning and enhance student academic success.
